- Clean mechanics for efficient, safe, and repeatable shooting principles
- Structured training that supports both individual improvement and dojo leadership development
- Testing (Shinsa) end of 2nd day for eligible practitioners

- Dojo leaders and senior students looking to strengthen teaching fundamentals
- Bow enthusiasts interested in traditional Japanese Archery methodology and disciplined practice
